Objectives

- Co-develop a user-friendly digital marketplace marketplace with local end users and service providers, ensuring full engagement of all stakeholders;
- Create new synergies among local businesses in the regions, improving competition and resilience while promoting the best services in the region;
- Validate the services offered through the marketplace which will serve as a one-stop-shop for service providers, public entities and citizens;
- Demonstrate the benefits of data sharing and interoperability across platforms from different sectors;
- Explore and validate new industry and business processes and innovative business models in the pilot regions;
- Boost sustainable post-project exploitation of the marketplace in dRural regions as well as its further uptake and replication in rural regions from across Europe.

- Access to new customers segments while raising visibility of local companies;
- Balanced supply and demand of services in rural areas;
